General Information:

- It is best to balance core courses (501, 502, 510, 511) with CRJ electives for registration.
- The Interactive Program of Study (iPOS) should be filed when you have reached 50% of your coursework.
- You must maintain a GPA of at least 3.0 in both your iPOS and overall graduate coursework to graduate.
- CRJ 505 (capstone) must be taken in your last semester of study and a grade of "B" or higher is required to graduate.
- A minimum of 27 hours must be taken at ASU.
- A maximum of 6 credits of CRJ 584 Internship may be applied towards your iPOS. CRJ 584 is not calculated towards GPA.
- All coursework must be completed within 6 years of taking your first course.
- All coursework must be graduate level courses (500 level or higher).
